Queenie's Apple Strudel & Hot Cocoa



INGREDIENTS:

4-5 sliced & peeled tart apples
2 teaspoons ground cinnation
3est of 1/2 a letison
1/2 cup sugar
Pinch of salt
1/2 cup raisins or pecans
1 cup breadcrutishs
1/2 cup inelted butter, plus
15 sheets phyllo pastty
Powdered sugar, for garnish
Cinnation, for garnish

Hot cocoa mix & whippped cream

- 1. Heat oven to 350 degrees F. and line baking sheet with parchment.
- 2. Stir together apples, cinnamon, lemon zest, sugar, salt, and raisins or nuts. Fold in breadcrumbs.
- 3. On your baking sheet, brush each phyllo sheet with melted butter and stack on top of one another.
- 4. Spread apple mixture over phyllo in a long row within 2 inches of one long side.
- 5. Fold the short edges in and roll the filling into the dough

until you have one long strudel.

- 6. Make sure the seam is on the bottom. Brush the top with melted butter.
- 7. Bake 35 minutes, or until golden brown. Let cool before you sprinkle the strudel with powdered sugar and cinnamon before serving.








Niffler


