Queenie's Apple Strudel & Hot Cocoa



INGREDIENTS:

4-5 sliced & peeled tart apples

2 teaspoons ground cinnamon

Zest of 1/2 a lemon

1/2 cup sugar

Pinch of salt

1/2 cup raisins or pecans

1 cup breadcrumbs

1/2 cup melted butter, plus

15 sheets phyllo pastry

Powdered sugar, for garnish

Cinnamon, for garnish

Hot cocoa mix & whipped cream

1. Heat oven to 350 degrees F. and line baking sheet with parchment.

2. Stir together apples, cinnamon, lemon zest, sugar, salt, and raisins or nuts. Fold in breadcrumbs.

3. On your baking sheet, brush each phyllo sheet with melted butter and stack on top of one another.

4. Spread apple mixture over phyllo in a long row within 2 inches of one long side.

5. Fold the short edges in and roll the filling into the dough

until you have one long strudel.

6. Make sure the seam is on the bottom. Brush the top with melted butter.

7. Bake 35 minutes, or until golden brown. Let cool before you sprinkle the strudel with powdered sugar and cinnamon before serving.

In *Fantastic Beasts and Where to Find Them*, Queenie makes strudel and hot cocoa for Newt Scamander and Jacob Kowalski when she and her sister hide them in their apartment. Strudel and cocoa are clearly the way to Jacob's heart. If you want to make your strudel just like Queenie, add some apple rosettes to the top before baking.

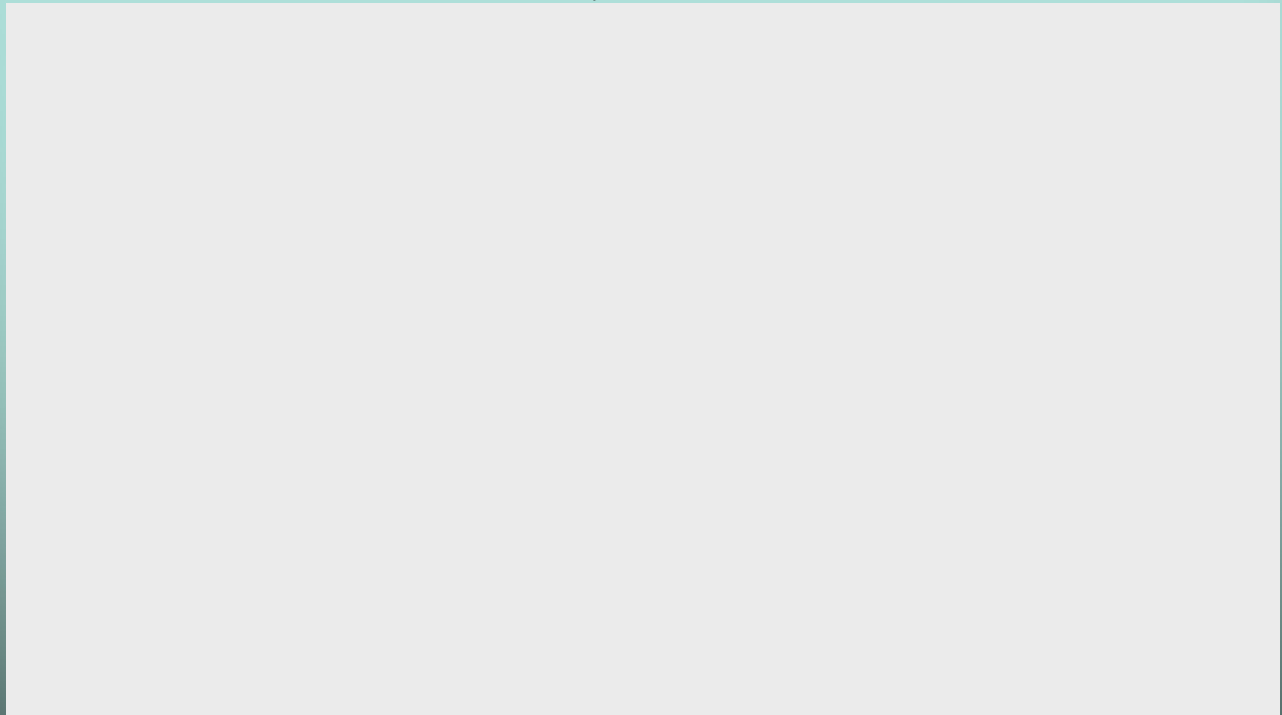

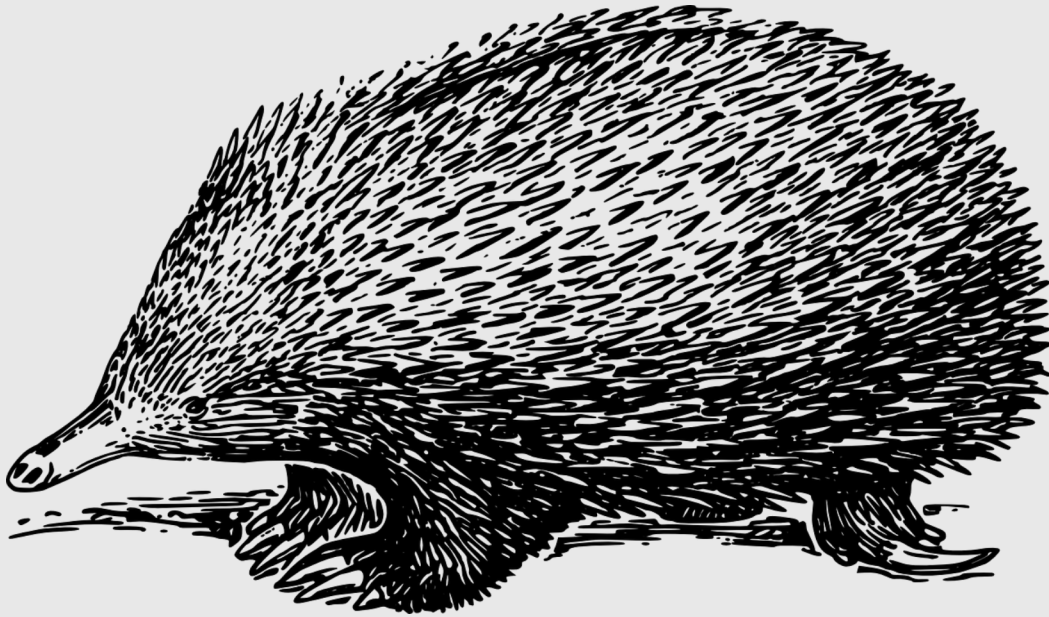

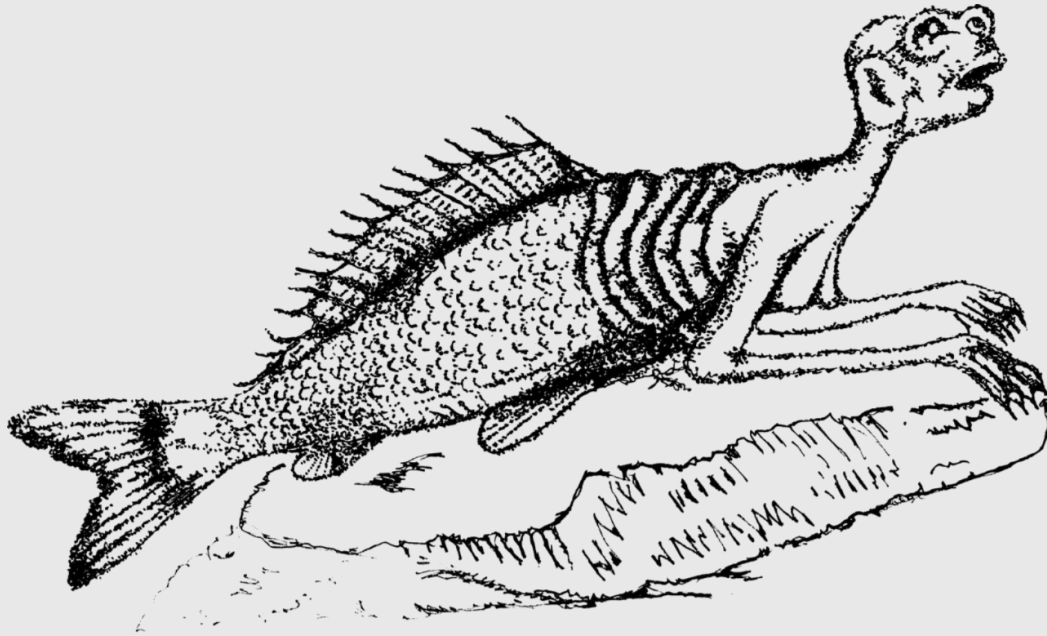
