

HOW TO DRAW A SIMPLE CARICATURE

CARICATURES ARE PORTRAITS OF PEOPLE WHOSE FEATURES HAVE BEEN BOTH SIMPLIFIED AND EXAGGERATED.

STEP 1:

CHOOSE A SUBJECT TO DRAW AND OBSERVE WHICH OF THEIR FACIAL FEATURES STAND OUT FROM THE REST.

STEP 2:

DECIDE WHICH OF YOUR SUBJECT'S FACIAL FEATURES YOU WANT TO EXAGGERATE.

STEP 7:

ADD DETAILS, LIKE EYEBROWS AND LASHES, SHADING, TATTOOS, EARRINGS, OR OTHER DISTINCTIONS.

STEP 6:

DRAW THE MOUTH. DECIDE WHETHER IT IS SMILING OR SERIOUS WITH FULL LIPS OR THIN. ADD TEETH IF DESIRED.



STEP 3:

USING A FELT TIP MARKER, DRAW AN OUTLINE OF YOUR SUBJECT'S FACE AND HAIR. PAY ATTENTION TO THE FACE SHAPE, CHEEK BONES,

STEP 5:

DRAW THE NOSE. SIZE AND SHAPE ARE KEY, AS WELL AS THE ANGLE.

STEP 4:

CHIN, AND FOREHEAD. NEXT DRAW THE EYES. PAY ATTENTION TO THEIR SHAPE AND ANGLE AS WELL AS WHERE THEY ARE IN RELATION TO THE OTHER FACIAL FEATURES.
