HOW TO DRAW A SIMPLE



CARICATURES ARE PORTRAITS OF PEOPLE WHOSE FEATURES HAVE BEEN BOTH SIMPLIFIED AND EXAGGERATED.

STEP 1:

STEP 7:

ADD DETAILS, LIKE EYEBROWS AND LASHES, SHADING, TATTOOS, EARRINGS, OR OTHER DISTINCTIONS.

STEP 6:

DRAW THE MOUTH. DECIDE WHETHER IT IS SMILING OR SERIOUS WITH FULL LIPS OR THIN. ADD TEETH IF DESIRED.

STEP 5:

DRAW THE NOSE. SIZE NEXT DRAW THE EYES. AND SHAPE ARE KEY, PAY ATTENTION TO THEIR AS WELL AS THE SHAPE AND ANGLE AS ANGLE. WELL AS WHERE THEY ARE IN RELATION TO THE OTHER FACIAL FEATURES.

CHOOSE A SUBJECT TO DRAW AND OBSERVE WHICH OF THEIR FACIAL **STEP Z:** FEATURES STAND OUT DECIDE WHICH OF YOUR FROM THE REST. SUBJECT'S FACIAL

USING A FELT TIP MARKER, DRAW AN OUTLINE OF YOUR SUBJECT'S FACE AND HAIR. PAY ATTENTION TO THE FACE SHAPE, CHEEK BONES, STEP 4: CHIN, AND FOREHEAD,
